Rules for the Mt. Baker Foothills Community Market

The cost to each vendor wishing to participate is \$12 per day, \$10 for Foothills Chamber of Commerce Members. There will be no exceptions.

Vendors must have a current Whatcom County Business License, (fee is \$15 per year), a copy of which must remain on file with the Chamber of Commerce.

Vendors are to supply their own booth which must be attractive and professional in appearance.

Vendors must be set up by 10:00 and remain until the market closes.

At least 75% of the items sold by any vendor must be grown or created by that vendor. The market is not intended for resale purposes.

Electricity may be available for an extra fee.

Vendors are responsible to clean up their booth area.

Vendors are not to park in any area that interferes with traffic into the market.

Vendors are not to create excessive noise that may disrupt renters in the cabins behind Cross Roads Grocery & Video.
